





Please indicate how familiar you are with the following being part of the Bologna Process:





What impact do you consider the Bologna Process has had in terms of ...





In which order would you prioritise your interest in dialogue and exchange on specific EHEA policy areas and tools?





- ☑ Analysis of the existing good practices, tools and projects related to EHEA
 - Three focus groups:
 - governments (5 May): representatives from 8 countries; Austria presented their national BFUG and other Bologna process related activities;
 - ENIC-NARICs, QA and promotion agencies (11 September): representatives from 10 countries 5 QAA, 2 QAA and ENIC-NARIC, 3 ENIC-NARIC
 - HEI and students (22 September): NCR, HEI and students federations representatives from 10 countries 4 students and 6 HEI together with EUA and ESU representatives members to the TF

- The BFUG Board decided to postpone the break-out sessions for **Bruxelles BFUG meeting** (19 20 February 2024).
 - Plenary session of 60 minutes to set the context and present the Recommendations, the background note and questions for discussions, as well as the purpose of the sessions;
 - 10 min break to move to the rooms;
 - 1 hour breakout discussion;
 - Plenary session of 30 minutes (the next day) to present the main outcomes and next steps (probably in the form of a panel).

Findings to feed into the recommendations.

Recommendations:

- III. Establish national Bologna hubs
- IV. Reform the Task Force and set up a Coordination Group within the BFUG
- V. Assure sustainable and consistent resources and funding dedicated to knowledge sharing

Recommendations:

- I. Ensure greater engagement of higher education stakeholders with the BFUG work
- Organise online information sessions about the main messages of the Ministerial Communiqué.
- •Organise **parallel sessions in the BFUG meetings with practitioners** to discuss specific thematic issues in depth.
- Organise events labelled as Bologna events or seminars aiming at facilitating exchange between BFUG and the HE sector.

Recommendations:

- I. Ensure greater engagement of higher education stakeholders with the BFUG work
- Consider establishing a **dedicated body or unit** at the ministry or mandate an existing organisation to coordinate and organise activities related to BP and ensure continuous dissemination of information.
- •Develop a **national strategy** dedicated to the BP implementation in collaboration with HE stakeholders. Include periodic monitoring of the impact of certain decisions, laws, tools implemented in HE, a communication strategy and a plan for organising trainings and support activities for different stakeholders.
- Develop a National Bologna Process Implementation Report.

Ministries



A2. Development of dissemination tools as videos and messages with EHEA visual identity, to be presented at the national/regional level and used for awareness-raising campaigns

- Topics to be developed:
- History and main features of the Bologna Process (draft script)
- **Present:** <u>fundamental values of HE</u>, mobility, flexible learning, recognition, inclusion, quality and relevance (+ the European Approach for the Evaluation of Joint Programs), <u>social dimension</u>,
- · Vision for the future: microcredentials, digitalisation, internationalisation,
- Why Bologna matters to you?: addressing directly different stakeholders.

Contribution from other WG?



A3. Series of TV/radio reportages /podcasts on topics related to the Bologna process

- Concept of a podcast series roundtable and interview type (definition, benefits, challenges, equipment)
 - o Podcast series example: The "EHEA: Transforming Education Together" → description, structure, host introduction, proposals of topics and outline of the first three episodes: Qualifications Frameworks compatible with the QF-EHEA, ECTS, Lisbon Recognition Convention.
- Concept to develop videos series short-form video content, video interviews, and feature presentations (definition, defined and examples of topics that are best to be tackled through each)
 - Feature video Example "Building Bridges: Connecting Higher Education Communities" → introduction, core ideas, script template, structure and duration

A4. Development of guidelines for the BFUG members to organise events, at national, regional or international level, including ideas of topics and formats

- **Event series guidelines** potential topics and event concepts
 - Example: "Empowering Education: Microcredentials and the Digital Learning Revolution" (mission and objectives, planning phase, including suggestions for planning team roles & responsibilities, format, programme, date, target audience and their needs, promotion and dissemination aspects, post event monitoring and evaluation, event planning task list (15 weeks prior - up to a week after event).



A5. Developing the concept and organising sessions and side events during the BFUG meetings related to the dialogue about the Bologna process

February BFUG meeting in Brussels:

- o capsules and video reportages looping on a screen,
- table for distributing handouts,
- o sitting corner that would allow inviting attendees to engage by creating capsules on the spot or participating in interviews producing videos with insights on how the BFUG works, which is the role of different types of participants, how decisions are being made etc.
