





Conference aims

The academic conference is intended as an analytical as well as an agenda-setting contribution to the design of the Bologna Process in the years to come and **it aims at identifying important future challenges for universities and their role in society.** The proceedings of this meeting will be input for the 2020 EHEA Ministerial Meeting in Rome.

The initiative will include a celebration day - on June 24th in the afternoon - and a working session on June 25th.

For the second day the scientific committee opened a Call for Abstracts on five themes: Academic and related civic values in changing societies, Student-centered Learning, Providing Leadership for Sustainable Development, the Role of Higher Education, The Social Dimension of Higher Education, Careers and Skills for the Labor Market of the future.

We received over **140** abstracts and have today more than **500** registered participants.

We really hope to involve many scholars, students and experts to discuss the core values of the European Higher Education Area and develop a "Vision" for the EHEA beyond 2020.


