

STEPS OF SUPPORT FOR KEY BOLOGNA COMMITMENTS





THE BICG

- Members should be nominated before and confirmed by the BFUG immediately following the Ministerial Conference. (ToR for the BICG - BFUG, Sofia, 2018)
- 7 members of the BICG nominated by the BFUG:
- representatives of 4 Bologna countries AT, BG, HR, IT
- European Commission
- EUA / EURASHE together representing the BFUG's consultative members
- representative of the BFUG WG 1.
- ...will be joined by the co-chairs of the Peer Groups.



WHAT HAS BEEN DONE SINCE PARIS?

- May 25th 2018, Paris: informal meeting of the BICG
- June 5th 2018, Bruxelles: first formal meeting
- August 30th 2018, Bruxelles, second formal meeting
- September 26th 2018, Vienna, third formal meeting (enlarged BICG)
 - Conducted a survey on expression of interest to join the Peer Groups;
 - Annalised the survey results overview of responses (Annex 01);
 - Proposed clustering of countries around thematic orientations (networking);
 - Drafted Guidelines for BFUG peer support.



PEER GROUPS

- Peer Groups aim to improve the implementation of the three key commitments;
- The Peer Groups create a platform for sharing knowledge, ideas and practices, for dialogue, mutual learning and understanding, discussing factors that are affecting implementation.
- The Peer Groups should agree on further actions such as peer support / peer counselling, exchange of experts, targeted seminars including national authorities and broader academic community, drafting legislative documents, etc.

PEER GROUP A - KEY COMMITMENT 1 Thematic orientations

- self-certification of the NQFs to the overarching QF EHEA,
- complete implementation of the ECTS User's Guide,
- short-cycle higher education,
- multiple purposes and use of the qualifications frameworks by the stakeholders,
- study programmes outside of the Bologna three-cycle structure,
- relationship between the qualifications frameworks and quality assurance.



PEER GROUP B - KEY COMMITMENT 2 THEMATIC ORIENTATIONS

- establishing the legal framework to allow the implementation of the LRC,
- establishing the distribution of work and responsibilities among the competent institutions that have the right knowledge and capacity to carry out recognition procedures,
- achieving automatic recognition,
- recognition of alternative pathways,
- qualifications held by refugees,
- optimising the potential of digital technology for the recognition agenda and the DS.



PEER GROUP C - KEY COMMITMENT 3 THEMATIC ORIENTATIONS

- legislative framework in line with the ESG (introducing changes),
- ensuring effectiveness of internal QA arrangements, including the use of QA results in the decision making process and quality culture as well as links to learning and teaching,
- the role and engagement of stakeholders in internal and external QA (students, teachers, employers),
- Cross-border QA and European Approach to accreditation of joint programmes.
