#### Some observations

- Some countries did not yet send in their national input
- Some countries did not fill out all sections
- There is not always coherence between the text and the table
- In some cases it is not clear if there has been communication and cooperation between the ministry and QA agency in filling the action plan

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## Umbrella project: Implementation and innovation in Quality Assurance through peer learning (IMINQA)

#### 2022-2025 (3 years) -> approved

- Total budget: max. 500,000 euro
- Partners: Ministry of Education and Training (BE/FC), ARACIS (RO), ENQA, EQAR
- Third co-chair (KZ) involved as expert
- Other experts: 1 from EUA, 1 from Romania



#### 2022-2025 (3 years) -> approved

- 7 WP's (6 content + 1 management)
  - Overall management -> start of project 1 May 2022
  - Organisation of TPG meetings (BE)
  - Staff mobility programme (BE)
  - 3 physical PLAs (EQAR)
  - 3 thematic WPs:
    - QA of Micro-credentials (ENQA)
    - QA of European Universities (BE)
    - Digitalisation of QA processes (RO)



#### **WP 2 TPG meetings**

#### 6 big Thematic Peer Group meetings over 3-year period

- Target group: whole TPG
- First meeting planned on 17-18/5/2022 @Belgium/Leuven
- Second meeting November 2022, online, date tbd
- In total 4 physical, 2 online meetings



#### WP 3 Staff mobility project

#### Individual needs of countries addressed

- Target group: all TPG-member countries and organisations
- System of mobility of staff members involved in QA within national authorities and/or quality assurance agencies and/or relevant stakeholder organisations
- Need for peer support and offer
- Good practice examples:
  - Duo-exchange
  - Internationalisation@home
  - Twin mobility of agency and ministry
  - Small group mobility
  - Shared hosting, blended format, ...
- See the <u>Final Report</u> of the previous staff mobility project.



#### WP 3 Staff mobility project

#### **Selection procedure:**

- Two calls for proposals: 2022 & 2023
- First call for proposals May-June 2022
- Deadline for application End July 2022
- Matchmaking committee evaluates the proposals August-September 2022
- Mobilities take place October 2022 end of March 2023
- Maximum of 2 staff members on mobility
- Joint application per country
- Financial incentive: 360-530 euro for travel, max. 120/night, max. 5 nights



#### **WP 4 Peer learning activities**

#### 3 peer learning activities will take place

Preparatory analysis & Cross-cutting analysis and report

- first PLA takes place on 1 September 2022 (BE)
   'Aligning the legal framework with the ESG'
- second PLA planned March 2023 (RO)
   'Cross-border QA (CBQA) & QA of TNE'
- third PLA Sept 2023 (BE)
   'European Approach to the QA of Joint Programmes'



#### **WP 4 Peer learning activities**

## The Peer Learning Activity 1 (PLA 1) - Aligning the legal frameworks with the ESG will address the following three topics:

- Topic 1: What are the key issues that need to be assured by the legal framework for internal and external QA?
- Topic 2: What are the main barriers in ensuring ESG compliance at national level and what are the effective approaches to address these issues?
- Topic 3: What is the status/role of external QA in different countries, and the balance between institutional and programme-level approaches to external QA and ESG compliance?



#### WP 5 Working group on QA of micro-credentials

- Build further on the recommendations of the MICROBOL project
- Setup of a working group
- Desk research
- Guiding documents for HEIs and QA agencies
- Inclusion of MC providers in EQAR
- Feasibility assessment on quality label
- Data standard for information on MCs
- Input to 2024 ministerial conference



#### WP 5 Working group on QA of micro-credentials

#### **Selection procedure:**

- Maximum 30 participants
- Call for nomination of representatives by 12 June 2022
- Small survey (reasons for joining, expertise, policy developments, practices, ...)
- Analysis of applications and selection of applicants indicating different levels of developments and different expertise will be invited to the group
- First meeting will be physically on 2 September 2022 in Belgium



#### WP 6 Working group on QA of European Universities

- Build further on the <u>EUNIQ</u> project
- Setup of a working group
- Analysis of legal obstacles in the participating countries in the WG (July 2022-December 2022)
- Feasibility study in 5 selected EHEA countries (April 2023-October 2023)
- 2 small PLA's (March 2023 & November 2023)
- Input to 2024 ministerial conference



#### WP 6 Working group on QA of European Universities

#### **Selection procedure:**

- Maximum 30 participants
- Call for nomination of representatives by 6 June 2022
- Small survey (reason why joining, expertise, European Universities in the country, structured cooperation between national policy level and universities, ...)
- Analysis of applications and selection of applicants indicating different levels of developments and different expertise will be invited to the group
- First meeting will be online on 17 June 2022



#### **WP 7 Digitalisation**

Focusses on how digitalisation could support quality assurance procedures and practices (post-COVID).

- Mapping (literature review, survey and interviews)
- activities undertaken by QA agencies and a presentation of the degree of digitalisation of QA processes,
- data management and data sharing,
- COVID impact.
  - ⇒ proposed directions of action.
- The outcomes will be shared and discussed during a thematic workshop, back-to-back with the last TPG meeting in November 2024.
