Task force (22 november 2021)

- Potential challenges in conducting a survey were discussed: existing surveys (EUA, BPIR...), and lack resources to conduct the investigation.
 - The potential benefits of working with the follow-up working group in charge of the Bologna Process Implementation Report (BPIR) were discussed and the we (co-chairs) agreed to meet with the co-chairs of this WG
- It was proposed to divide the large theme of "Learning and teaching" into 3 sub-themes in which the roadmap will clearly include the concrete actions assigned to the whole group (survey, measurable indicators, PLA, best practices, concrete recommendations)
 - ✓ Student-centered learning
 - ✓ Support staff development
 - ✓ Foster innovative teaching and learning

Task force (22 november 2021)

Mode of work of the subgroups

- Each sub-group will be chaired by a WG co-chair.
- The sub-groups will meet between WG meetings and report back to the WG on their progress
- The work of each subgroup will culminate in a PLA.
- WG members can choose to attend 1 or all of the sub-groups but it is desirable that the 3 sub-groups be approximately equal in size and that each member can free up enough time to contribute meaningfully to the group goals.
- PLA meetings will be open to all EHEA countries and BFUG advisory members, not just WG members.
