BOLOGNA IMPLEMENTATION COORDINATION GROUP (BICG)

<u>Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia</u>, EUA, EURASHE, European Commission, Italy, one Co-chair of WG1 on Monitoring, one Co-chair of Peer Group A on QF, one Co-chair of Peer Group B on LRC, one Co-chair of Peer Group C on QA.

Austria, Bulgaria, and Croatia are Co-chairs.

- Thematic Peer Group A on Key Commitment 1 (a three-cycle system compatible with the overarching Qualifications Framework of the EHEA and first and second cycle degrees scaled by ECTS)
- Thematic Peer Group B on Key Commitment 2 (national legislation and procedures compliant with the Lisbon Recognition Convention [LRC])
- **Thematic Peer Group C** on Key Commitment 3 (Quality Assurance in compliance with the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area)

Specific thematic indications include topics such as:

- > establishing the legal framework to allow the implementation of the LRC,
- Sestablishing the distribution of work and responsibilities among the competent institutions that have the right knowledge and capacity to carry out recognition procedures,
- > achieving automatic recognition,
- recognition of alternative pathways,
- > qualifications held by refugees,
- optimising the potential of digital technology for the recognition agenda and the Diploma Supplement.







The BFUG is working on **the future of the EHEA** in terms of structure and new topics (consultations at BFUG level and at national level + Bologna Declaration XX Anniversary).

The questionnaire for the **Bologna Process Implementation Report 2020** was sent to BFUG countries (deadline 12th of June).
