



Bologna Process for Learning and Teaching

BP4LnT Project

Overview

The *Bologna Process for Learning and Teaching (BP4LnT)* supports the implementation of the Bologna Process commitments on student-centred learning (SCL) and lifelong learning (LLL) across the European Higher Education Area (EHEA). Coordinated by EURASHE, the project brings together universities, students, and governments to bridge institutional practice with European policy dialogue.

Learning and teaching are at the heart of the Bologna Process, yet their full implementation remains uneven across Europe. BP4LnT aims to translate ministerial commitments into concrete progress by exploring how SCL and LLL are embedded in institutional strategies and supported at the system level. It does so by linking research, peer learning, and evidence-based discussion with the work of the Bologna Follow-Up Group (BFUG).

Objectives

- Enhance understanding of SCL and LLL and their implementation across the EHEA.
- Support peer learning between higher education institutions, students, and national authorities.
- Bring structured, research-informed discussions on learning and teaching into the BFUG.

Project narrative

Through research, consultations, and peer learning activities, BP4LnT examines how institutions and systems develop flexible, inclusive, and learner-oriented approaches to education. Two *Playbooks*—on student-centred learning and lifelong learning—will summarise the findings, examples of good practice, and recommendations for both institutions and policymakers.

To ensure the results inform European-level dialogue, the project will organise three EHEA Policy Events, held back-to-back with BFUG meetings. These events will bring together higher education authorities, institutional leaders, and stakeholder representatives to debate the future of learning and teaching in Europe and prepare inputs for the 2027 Ministerial Conference.
