

Peer Learning Activity “We make a change’: Making institutional cultures in higher education more inclusive”

Peer Learning Activity (PLA), titled “**We make a change’: Making institutional cultures in higher education more inclusive**”, is organised within the framework of the INSPIRE project, led by the Co-chairs of Thematic Peer Group D on Social Dimension and partners.

The PLA focuses on Principle 5 (Counselling and guidance) and Principle 7 (Inclusive institutional culture) of the Principles and Guidelines to Strengthen the Social Dimension of Higher Education in the EHEA. It aims to explore how higher education institutions and systems can strengthen counselling, guidance, and support services, while fostering inclusive institutional cultures that enable all students to participate, progress, and succeed.

Through peer presentations, interactive discussions, and exchange of practices, the PLA will provide a platform for participants to reflect on how counselling and guidance services contribute to inclusive learning environments, and how institutional culture, leadership, and everyday practices can support systemic and sustainable change. The activity will emphasise practical experiences, challenges, and lessons learned, supporting mutual learning across EHEA members.

A dedicated PLA report will be prepared following the activity, capturing key discussions, examples of good practice, and transferable insights to inform future work within TPG D and the broader EHEA framework.
