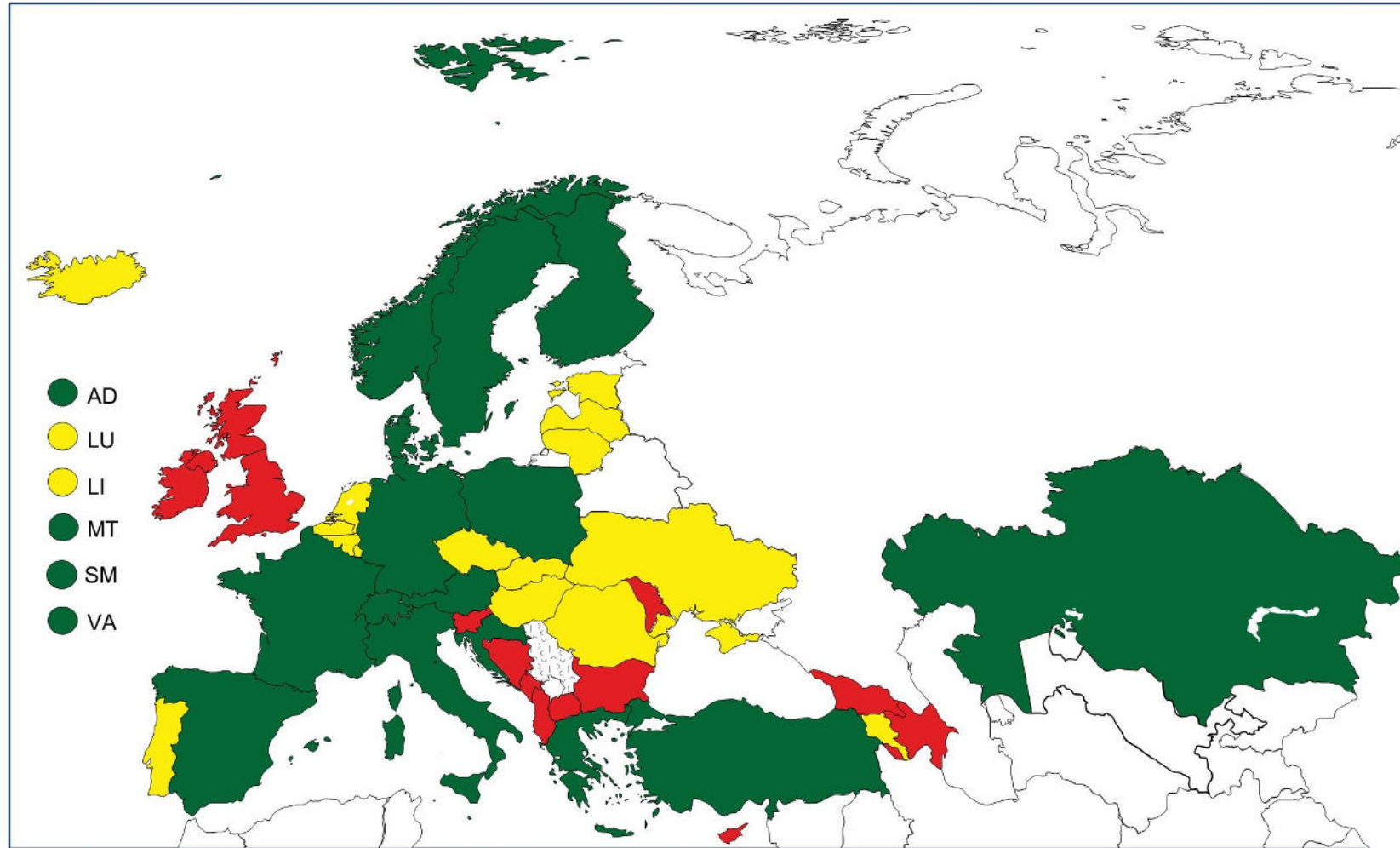
Concept




- Developed in EHEA since 2012 (establishment of Pathfinder Group)

“Automatic recognition of a degree leads to the automatic right of an applicant holding a qualification of a certain level to be considered for entry to a programme of further study in the next leave in any other EHEA country”

- Council Recommendation, 2018: AR within the EU by 2025
- Rome Communiqué: commitment to guarantee automatic recognition at system level of academic qualifications delivered in EHEA countries where quality assurance operates in compliance with ESG and NQF

System-level automatic recognition for academic purposes, 2022/2023

19 systems

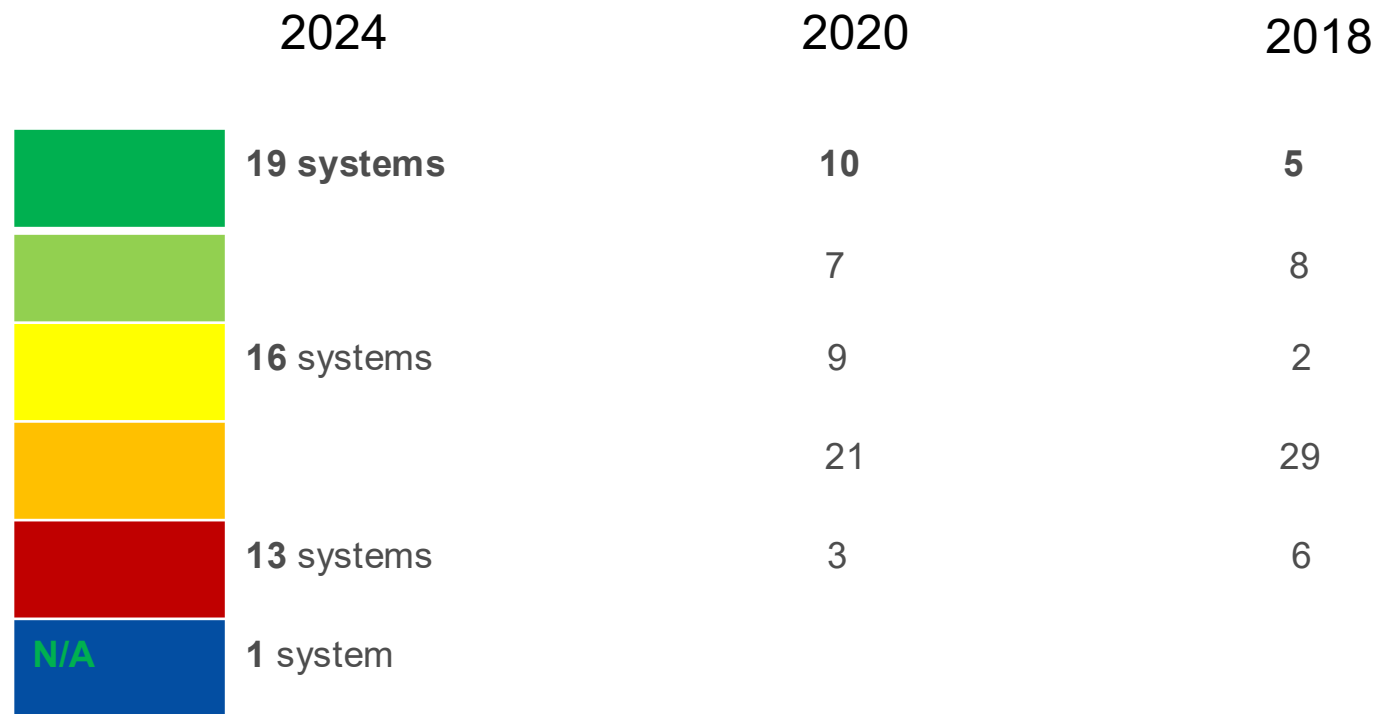
For some systems
