# Shaping the 2027 Report

- Structure approved by BFUG in Warsaw...
- Report aligned with policy priorities and working group structures
- Composed of two types of information:
  - a) indicators on policy development
  - b) narrative text on progress in implementation in each thematic area



# Indicators

- Volume of information collected for 2024 report was not sustainable
- Agreement to significantly reduce indicators, and therefore also the burden of information coming from BFUG members
- Indicator proposal shared with all working groups, and to be discussed/approved by BFUG in Copenhagen



# Fundamental Values: a particular case

- Approach of Monitoring and FV values groups will be fully aligned
- NewFav2 project developing monitoring framework for FV – using several sources of data, and mediated by national operators
- Agreement that questions to public authorities will be asked in the questionnaire to the BFUG, and answers shared with project



# What will be included in the BPIR on FV?

- At this stage, we don't know
- Narrative text, explaining the progress in developing a monitoring framework, is possible. This text should be written by a designated member of the FV WG
- De jure indicators also possible – but not necessarily desirable, as this risks creating division with the methodology of the NewFV 2 project
- Also possible for the FV WG report, incorporating outcomes of the NewFav2 project, to be a standalone report on fundamental values for the 2027 Ministerial Conference



# Narrative text for FV chapter (if it's to be included)

Author should be proposed by FV WG

Draft text should be written summer 2026 – following common guidelines (to be discussed/agreed at BFUG Copenhagen)

General editor will be responsible for harmonisation, under auspices of WG monitoring
