Regional trends' impact on other world regions

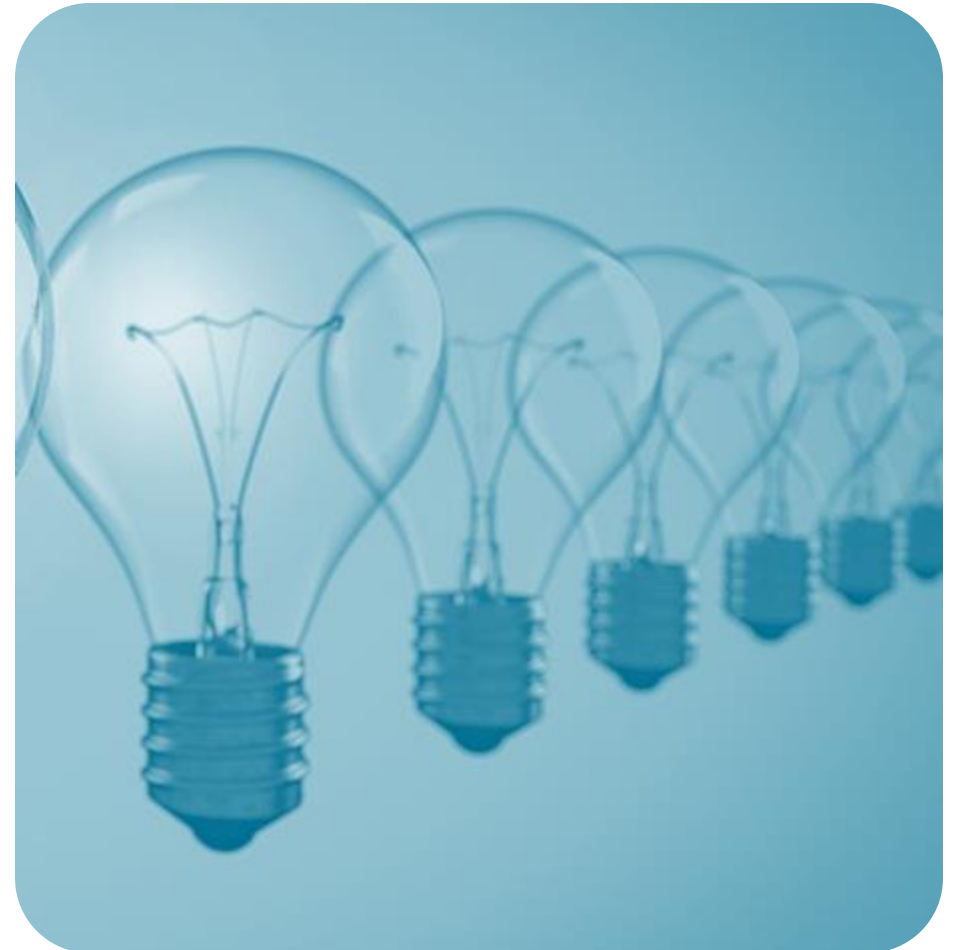
- Benchmarking when updating regional standards:
