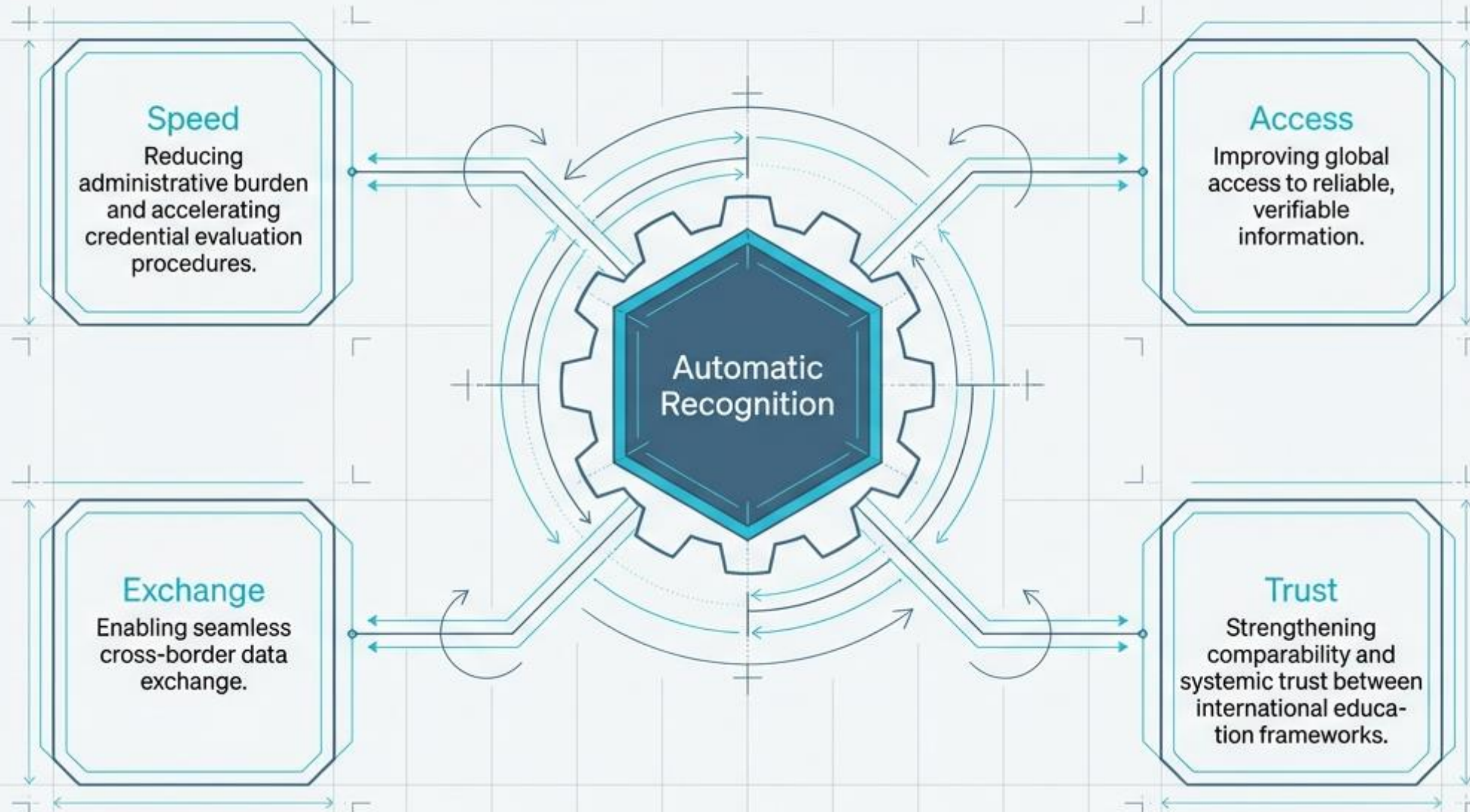

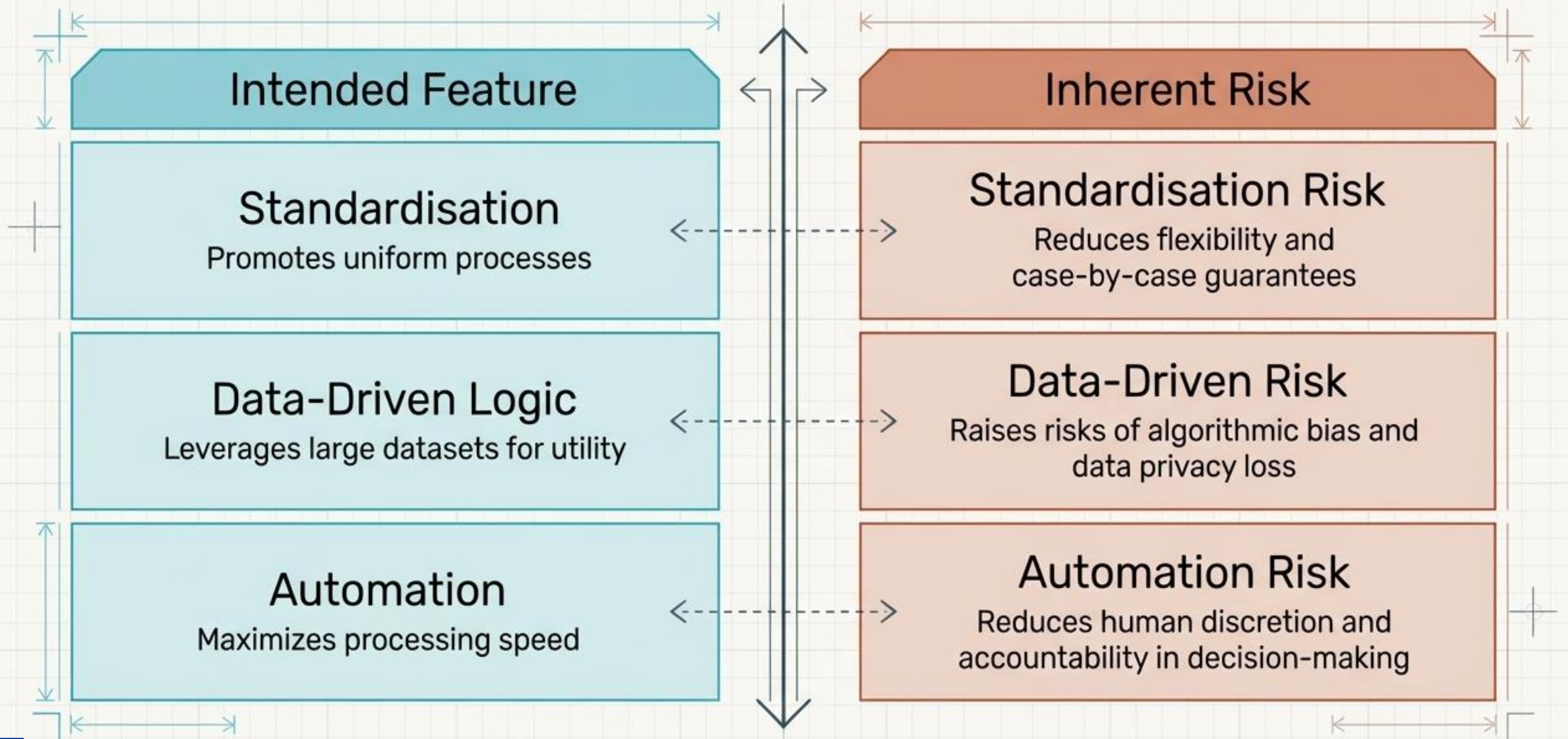

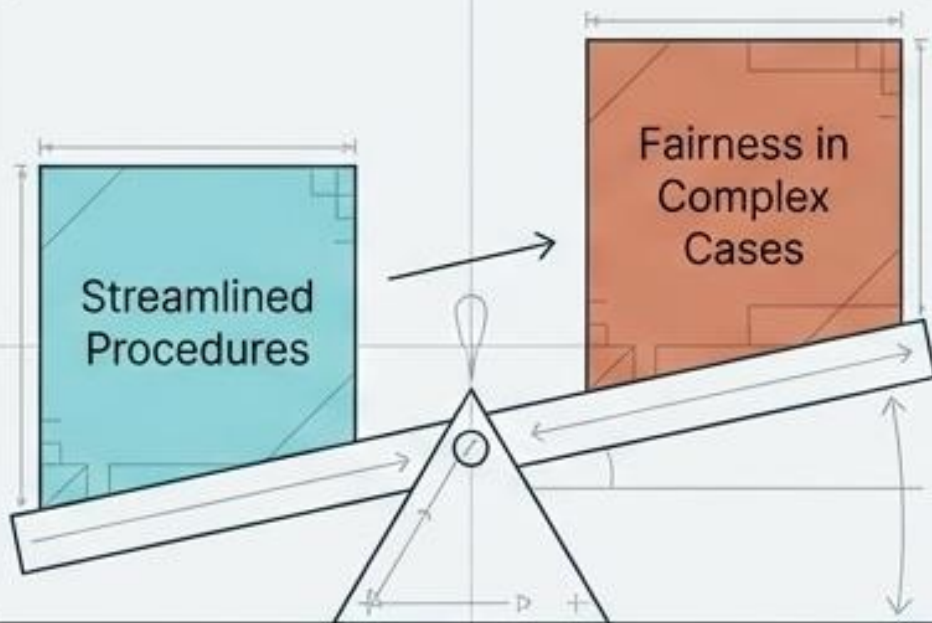
## The Trajectory of Drift



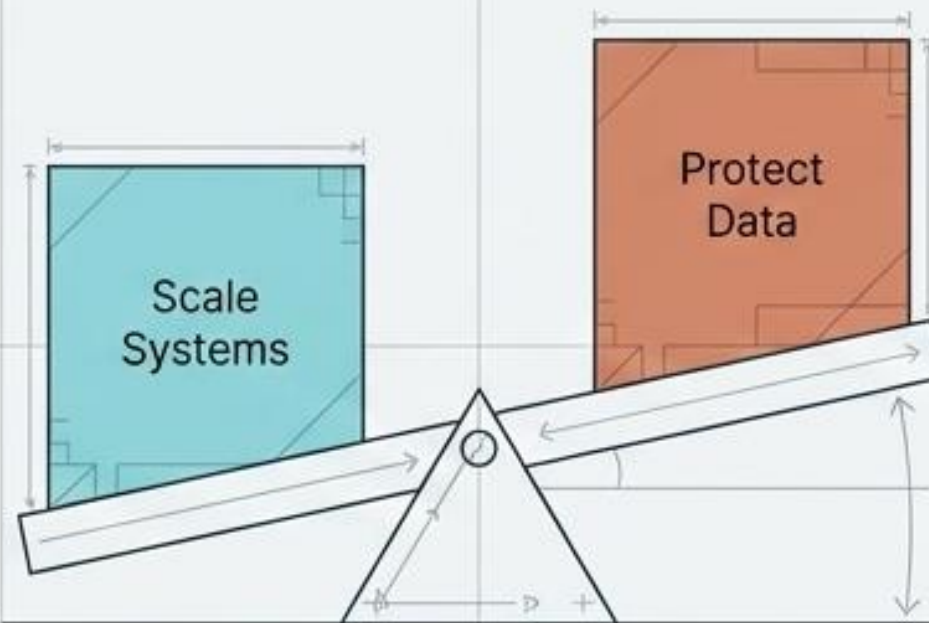

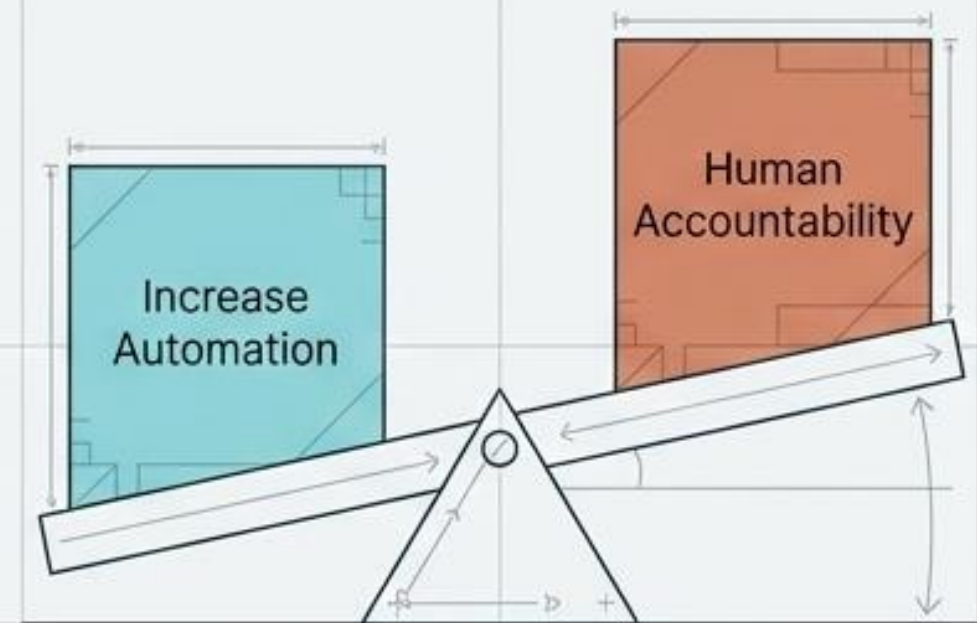
## The Balancing Act



Can we streamline procedures without losing the ability to assess complex cases fairly?

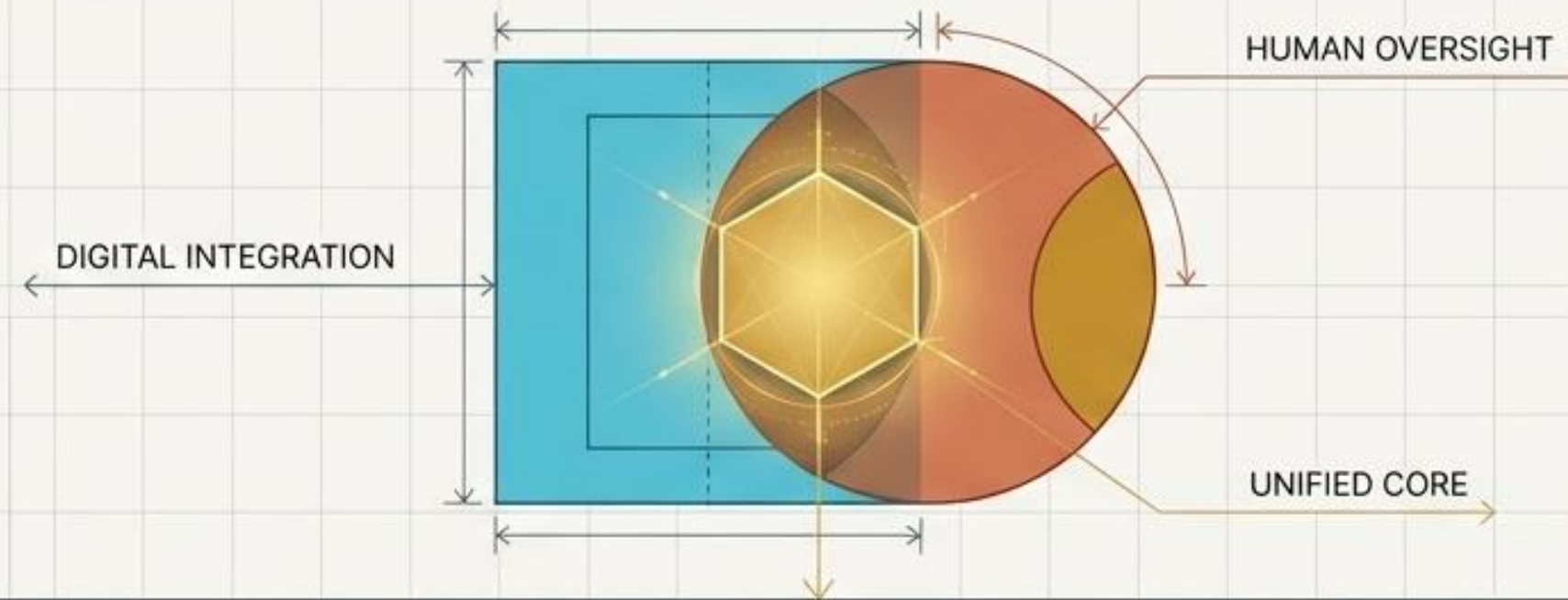


How do we scale data-driven systems while strictly protecting personal data?

# The Paradigm Shift

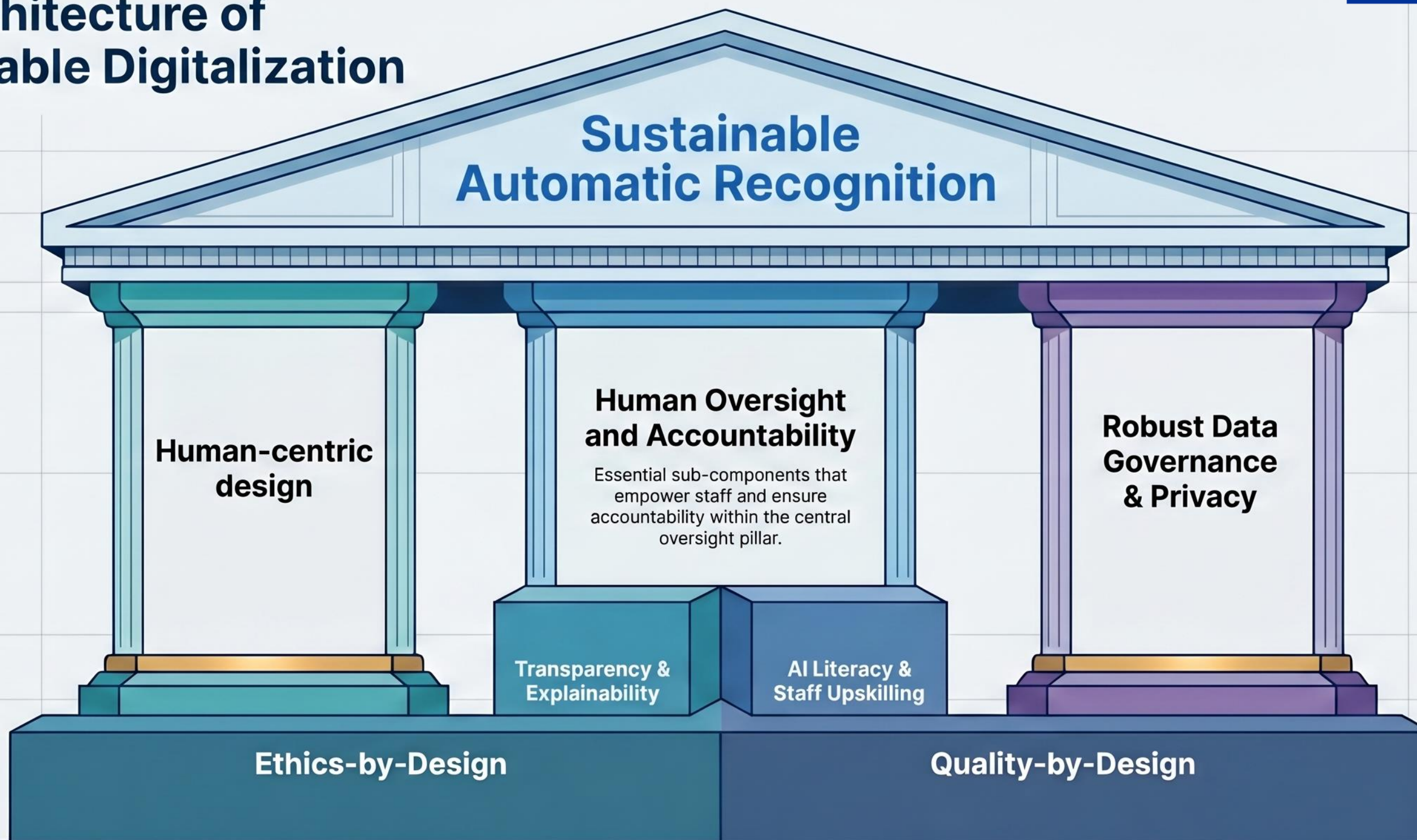


**The challenge is not whether to digitalise,
