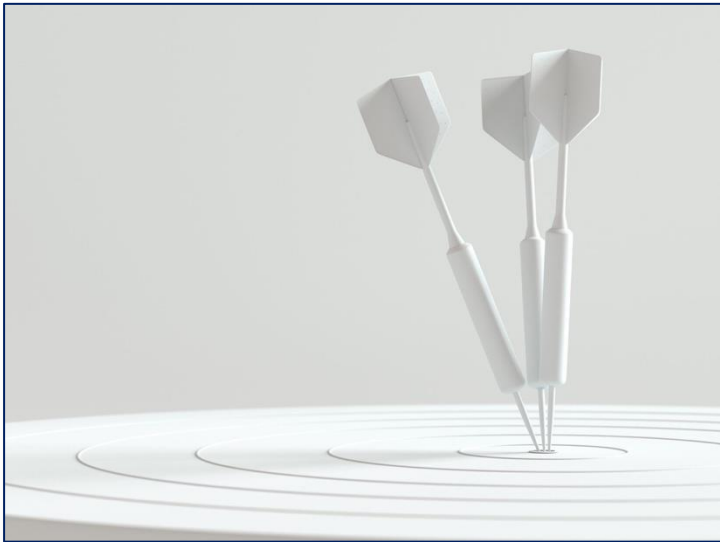

Project Objectives



AIM

Supporting the implementation of the Bologna Process focusing on the key commitment 2 on national legislation and procedures compliant with the Lisbon Recognition Convention (LRC) in the countries being part of the Thematic Peer Group B (TPG B). All project activities were implemented using the **peer support approach**.

01

Strengthened TPG B Capacity

Enhanced capacity to contribute to attaining more even implementation of the 6 specific thematic indications identified by the BFUG for the Group and under the aegis of the BICG.

02

Enhanced Ownership

Improved ownership and information sharing between national authorities, higher education institutions and other relevant stakeholders.

03

Strengthened Cooperation

Enhanced cooperation and sharing of practices between stakeholders involved in recognition processes.

Automatic Recognition

Automatic recognition of qualifications and learning periods abroad.



Flexible Learning

Flexible learning pathways and lifelong learning, including micro-credentials.



Transnational Cooperation

Transnational cooperation in higher education and recognition of qualification awarded by transnational education institutions.



Digital Transition

Digital transition on higher education, supporting recognition of qualifications.

Publication on TNE

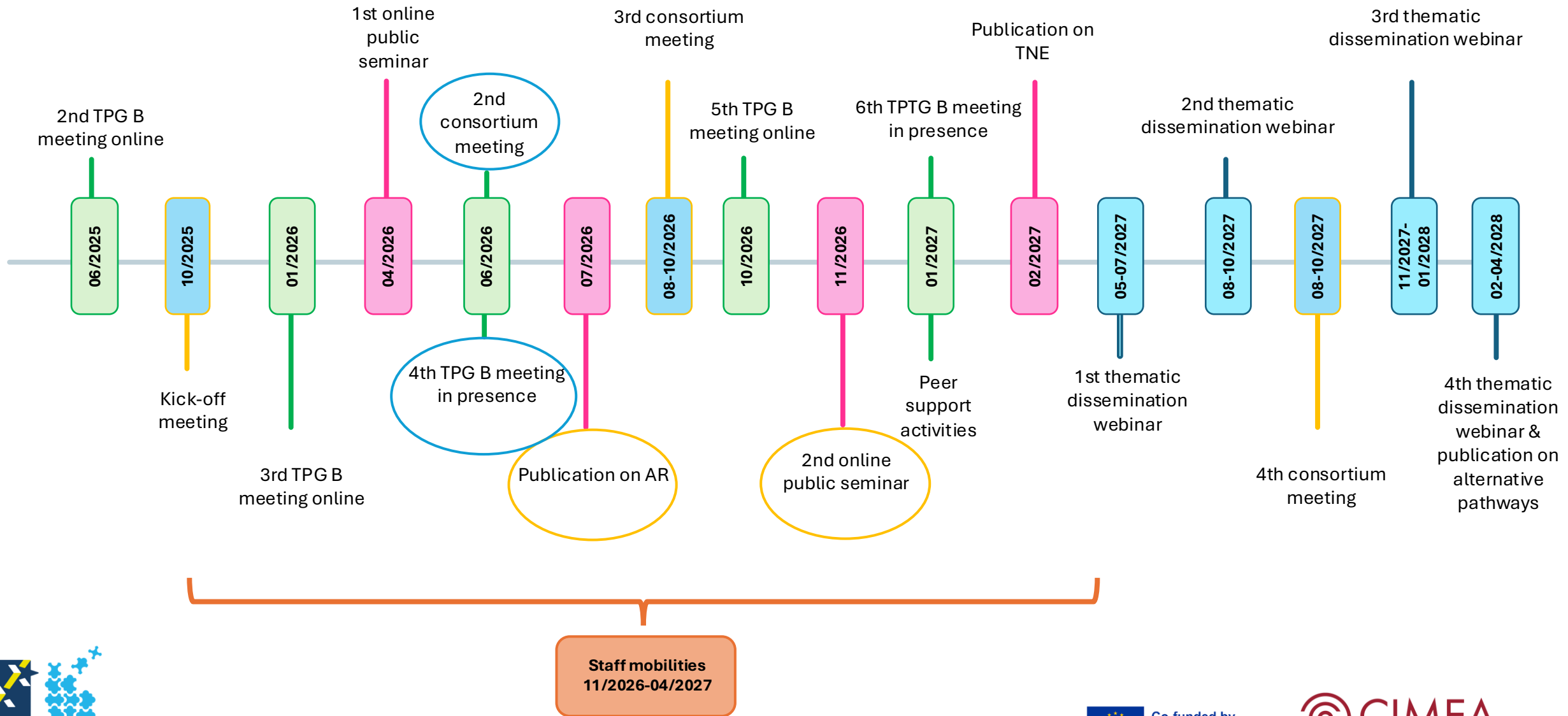
- Drafted by the **WG2**: Italy, France, Ukraine (TPG B Co-Chairs) and TPG A and TPG C Co-Chairs.
